<b>Role Details</b>	<p>We are a thriving Church of England, Voluntary Aided lower school in a beautiful setting in Leighton Buzzard. Applicants are expected to support our Christian ethos. We pride ourselves on being an inclusive school, which is recognised for the quality of its values and relationships.</p> <p>We seek to appoint an enthusiastic, fully flexible individual to work initially across our Key Stage 2 team. The successful applicant will be prepared to work inside and outdoors, providing occasional support in our Forest School environment, as well as across key stages, if required. Depending upon experience, this could be a Level 3 role, requiring the job holder occasionally to deputise for the class teacher for courses and short-term unplanned absences.</p> <p>The successful applicant must be experienced in delivering: clear pronunciation of English is therefore also essential.</p> <p>Ideally, candidates will have a minimum of 2 years' TA experience in the last 5 years. Knowledge of working with children in an educational setting, of curriculum and learning strategies and an understanding of children's needs including physical needs would be an advantage.</p> <p>Applicants must be good team players, with a positive can-do attitude. They must be educated to GCSE level including English and Maths at grades A-C or equivalent. Ideally, candidates will hold or be working towards a full and relevant Level 3 Qualification. Willingness to train is key, along with being comfortable working under one's own initiative.</p>
