The learning covered in the planning is taken from the EYFS profile and is not restricted just to the main learning intentions. During the whole school year, the children will cover, on several occasions, every point in the seven areas of learning. The children also cover the 1st phase of Letters and Sounds during the school year. The learning is also undertaken in several forms, within the Pre-school environment, to encompass the learning style of all children.
