Here are just a few practical pointers, to help a smooth transition next week.

1.Drop off/Pick up gates and timings

Pre-school	8.45am – 3.15pm	at porch door on the hill.
Reception	8.50am – 3.30pm	to enter the very top black single gate, leading down to the playground
KS1	8.45am – 3.25pm	The main double black gate at the bottom of the hill, near our office.
KS2	8.50am – 3.30pm	(same place as KS1)

2.Uniform

Please make sure your child has smart, named, uniform with black shoes. Longer hair, for boys and girls, to be tied back.

3. Timeliness

Please arrive in good time so they don't miss anything at the very beginning of the day. Starting learning together is a really positive way to begin their day.

4. Water bottles

Please remember to bring a named water bottle in with your child, every day. These are used in class and at lunchtimes. This initiative has saved a huge amount of plastic waste. Thanks for your ongoing commitment to this.
