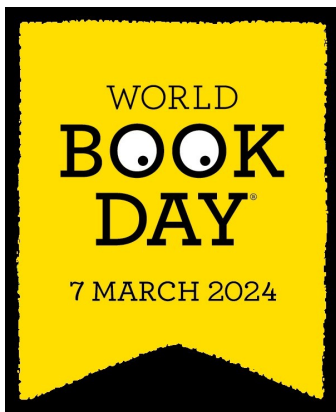

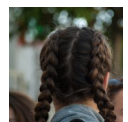


Tidy Long Hair/ fringes
