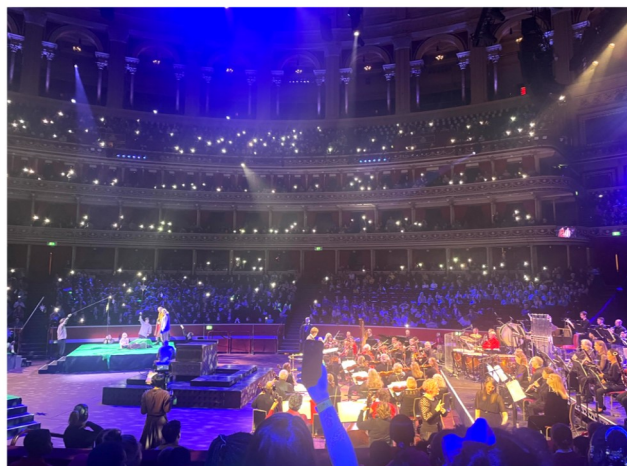

So please may we all take extra care on the hill whether we are in a vehicle, on a bike or scooter or on foot.

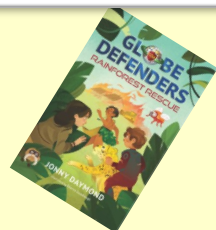
