The donut selling on the 19th April was a complete sell out! Sorry to those that didn't manage to buy one, we will ensure we have even more supplies the next time we do it.

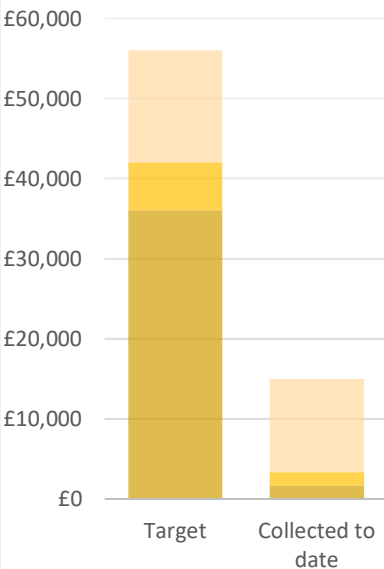
In our recent meeting we discussed the events that will take us to the end of this school year, so please see the dates for the diary, as we have a few new ones added.
