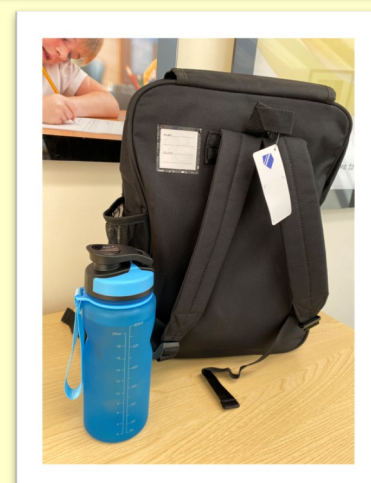
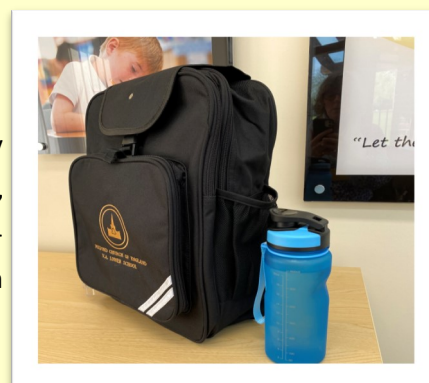
### New School Bag

Made of strong, waterproof material with 3 zipped compartments, adjustable straps and a small velcro pencil case attached inside the first pocket. It has plenty of space to hold a PE kit/change of clothes, reading books, an afterschool snack and a water bottle (side pocket to hold it upright) on the outside.
